1. Your research proposal presentation has been scheduled from 17th of March 2022.
2. The format for cover page of research proposal in word document format is attached hereby. The format for the research proposal hard copy and ppt has already been sent by Coordinator Academics in the former mails.
3. You are required to submit three copies of the research proposal to your respective guide(s).
4. You need to adhere to the formats and specifications given by the undersigned for all submissions without fail.
5. In addition to research proposal hard copy every student should ensure that he/she gets the research proposal **recommendation form and guide agreement form (3 copies) duly signed by the respective guides** and submit it to the undersigned before presentation schedule given, to

obtain the slots on the scheduled date of proposal presentation or you shall not be allowed to make the presentations.

6. In the hard copy cover page the name and register number of the students has to be as per the University records.
7. It is mandatory for the entire batch to attend the proceedings for the proposal presentation. Attendance will be marked for all students for the period of research proposal presentation.

Please note the details of the attachments below-

1. Cover page for research proposal hard copy.
2. Informed consent form (1 filled in copy to be carried on the day of the presentation along with your scale/s, tools, its scoring and interpretation)
3. Socio demographic data (SDD) sheet (each of you need to discuss with the guide and finalize the requirements of SDD)
4. Research guidance agreement form (3 copies to be submitted along with the proposal hard copy)
5. Guide recommendation form (3 copies to be submitted along with the proposal hard copy)
