

Indian Institute of Psychology and Research (IIPR) is a premier college in Bangalore that offers postgraduate courses in Psychology and undergraduate courses with Psychology as one of the major subjects alongside other multidisciplinary subjects. The college is affiliated to Bengaluru City University (BCU) which is one among the universities trifurcated from Bangalore University. Library and Laboratory

Psychology laboratory and Media labs are places where students apply their theoretical knowledge into tests by practicing and developing the required skills under faculty supervision. Being equipped with the best-in class instruments and assessment tools covering various branches of psychology, practical classes are the most sought after for its hands-on training in skill development.

Availability of media labs for journalism students equipped with facilities to practice photography, Audio-Video recording and editing technology is an added attraction for students.

Canteen

IIPR Counselling Centre

The centre provides various services such as individual/personal and group counselling, counselling for children, adolescents, college students and working professionals, Psychometry, Psychological assessment, screening, profiling, counselling and guidance for study skills, relationship management, career planning, stress management, life skills, work life balance, family and marriage counselling, promotion of positive mental health and wellbeing.

Curriculum and Teaching

IIPR follows the curriculum of Bangalore City University for undergraduate and postgraduate courses. The faculty use hands-on methodology in teaching and training students making learning an experiential process. The teachers aim to play the role of educators and mentors going way beyond the traditional methods of imparting knowledge. Students are encouraged to forge their path, take legitimate risks, make mistakes and learn, ask questions and find answers thereby promoting a scientific temper.

The academic fervor, the quality of teaching and learning processes bear witness to the astonishing results that the students have been procuring in university examinations. On an average close to 90 to 95 percent of our students secure first class results with an equally high number of 'distinctions' and 'exemplary' results. Students of the Post graduate courses have been securing nearly 7-8 ranks out of the 10 ranks awarded in the university examinations.



Value Added Programmes (VAP)

In addition to the prescribed curriculum, IIPR offers Value Added Programmes such as Extra Curricular Activities (ECA), Current Affairs (CA) and Academic Enrichment Programmes (AEP) every week to the students. Weekend certificate courses are available for advanced learners to optimize their potential. Students are given extensive support and encouragement to attend and present papers at workshops, seminars, symposia and conferences to facilitate better learning and placement opportunities. VAPs and AEPs are intended to make the students abreast with current affairs and latest developments in the field of their interest.

Extra Curricular Activities and Co-curricular activities are incorporated into the campus life with one hour every week dedicated for the same to promote well-rounded and holistic growth of the students. It offers a platform for students to foster leadership, teamwork, event management skills and provides opportunities for display of a wide array of their skills and talents.

Students Assistance Programmes

Bridge courses, remedial teaching, mentoring and other student assistance programmes are offered to those students who require additional personal attention. Assistance for internship and placement services provided through the placement cell with the help of a wide network of associated NGOs, Hospitals, Clinics, Counselling Centers, Rehabilitation centers and Organizations. College uses user friendly technical interface and Learning Management Systems (LMS) such as **CAMU**, **Google classroom**, **and Google education apps** for updating information related to student performance, assignment submissions, resource materials sharing, attendance and regularity, library books issue and return reminders, important events and announcements from college, sharing of photo gallery etc. Both students and parents can access all this information. Parent access is available through CAMU app to track student attendance, progress, performance in internal assessments and important announcements.

Admission Process

Application Process

- The applications forms for UG, PG, PG Diploma programs are available online, on the college website – www.iipr.in
- Students have to fill all the mandatory columns completely to successfully submit the application form.
- The application fee payment can be done through the payment gateway https://rzp.io/l/8avVl3BtgX

UG Courses – Rs. 750/-PG Courses – Rs. 1500/-PG Diploma Courses – Rs. 1000/-

Selection Process

- UG Courses personal interviews are in person and online mode
- PG Courses based on entrance test, personal interviews are in person and online mode
- PG Diploma Courses personal interviews are in person and online mode
- The selected students have to make the payment of course fee and submit the original mark sheets and documents within the stipulated deadline before the commencement of classes.

Documents to be enclosed along with the application form:

For UG Applications: Attach self-attested copies of - 10th Mark sheet, 11th Mark sheet (Report Card), 12th Mark sheet (if available), Conduct Certificate, Any Government Photo ID (Aadhar, Driving License, Passport, PAN, etc) for verification (recommended ID proof Aadhar), Transfer Certificate, Migration Certificate.

For PG Applications: Attach self-attested copies of - 10th Mark sheet, 12th Mark sheet, Degree Mark sheets (semesters available as on date), Degree Certificate/ Provisional Degree Certificate(if available), Conduct Certificate, Government Photo ID (Aadhar, Driving License, Passport, PAN, etc) for verification (recommended ID proof Aadhar), Transfer Certificate, Migration Certificate.

If the Application is incomplete or incorrect, the application will be rejected. Original copies of all the above listed documents should be submitted to complete the admission process.

Personal Interview Process

Receipt of applications will be acknowledged by an email to the candidate/parent. After scrutinizing the applications, applicants meeting the eligibility criteria will be notified regarding the dates for Personal Interview/Online Interview. The office of admissions will correspond with the candidate in this regard over email.

An interview is used to assess the candidate's subject knowledge, aptitude, communication skills, attitude, and overall suitability to the course. All original documents need to be produced for verification at the time of Personal Interview. Online interview opted candidates are required to complete the document verification process at the time of admission.

Candidates who have opted for an Online Interview will be notified with the guidelines for the same. Candidates who have applied for the PG course will first appear for an Entrance exam and then attend the personal interview. Entrance exam (only for PG applicants): Postgraduate applicants will have objective type exam, it will cover general awareness and the papers that are generally part of all undergraduate courses- General Psychology, Developmental Psychology, Abnormal Psychology, Industrial Psychology, Counselling Psychology, Health Psychology, Research Methods and Statistics in Psychology.

Admission Process

Candidates selected for admission will be intimated within 2 working days after the personal/online interview with further guidelines to complete the admission process along with the course fee details.

Selected candidates have to pay the stipulated Course Fee (fee for two- semester/one academic year) within 4 working days and submit all the original documents to confirm the admission. Kindly get in touch with office.admissions@iipr.inforfurtherdetails.

Fee paid receipt and acknowledgment of document submission will be issued by the office of admissions on completion of the admission process.

All admissions are subjected to approval from Bengaluru City University (BCU). Hence candidates' original documents will be submitted to authorities concerned at BCU for the admission approval process. On completion of the approval, the original documents will be returned to the candidates by the end of the first semester.

Waitlisted candidates will be given admission if any seat falls vacant or against cancellation only. The update in this regard will be given by the Office of Admissions IIPR.

Payment of course fees can be made by DD/Online Transfer.

Original Document required to complete the final admission process:

Original Marks Sheets of all qualifying exams to be submitted, Degree Certificate / Provisional Degree Certificate from the university conferring the degree (for PG applicants), Conduct certificate from the institute last attended, Transfer certificate, Migration certificate, Caste/Category Certificate (if applicable), Income Certificate (if applicable), Copy of Passport and Visa (Foreign Nationals), Letter from the concerned embassy office (Foreign Nationals), Indian passport size photographs - 4 numbers.

(Do not send any original documents with the application; all the above mentioned original documents are required at the final admission process).

Note: The decision of the Admission Committee is final and binding in all matters related to the admission process and selection.
