


Alumni of IIPR

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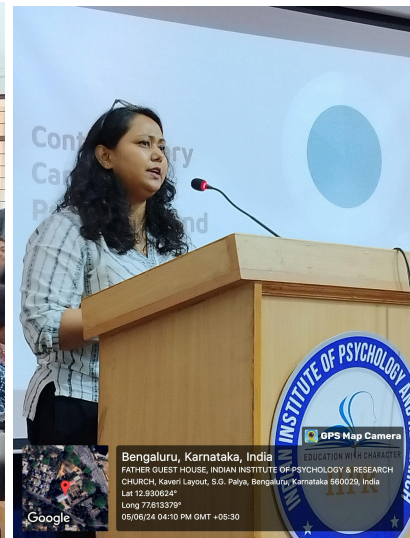

Dear Students,

For this week's **Academic Enrichment Programme (AEP)**, on **12th June 2024 (Wednesday)** between **4 pm and 5 pm**, we have an **Interactive Session 'On the Importance of Community'**, in the **College Auditorium**. The programme is a series of Alumni Connect Initiatives organised in collaboration with the IQAC of IIPR.

We have today Dr. Kalpana Purushothaman who is presently working as a Member of the Juvenile Justice Board, Bangalore (Urban), which is a three-member judicial bench that adjudicates the cases of children in conflict with the law for Bangalore Urban district. She is also an Adjunct Professor of Social and Community Psychology at the Indian Institute of Psychology and Research Bangalore. She is also the founder of Project MAANASA which is a unique psychosocial initiative established in 2010 which operates out of the MAANASA Wellness Centre at the Government Observation Home for Boys, in Madivala, Bangalore. A multidisciplinary project set up under the directions of the Honorable High Court of Karnataka, in collaboration with the Karnataka State Legal Services Authority, the Juvenile Justice Board, Bangalore (Urban) and the District Child Protection Office, Bangalore (Urban), Project MAANASA provides a range of psychosocial services including individual, group and family counselling, educational services, life skills education, sports and recreational activities, awareness and sensitisation workshops, training and capacity building, placement in vocational training and referral services, for children, families and functionaries in the juvenile justice system.

Some of our alumni who have been associated with Project MAANASA will also be part of the programme for interaction with students.

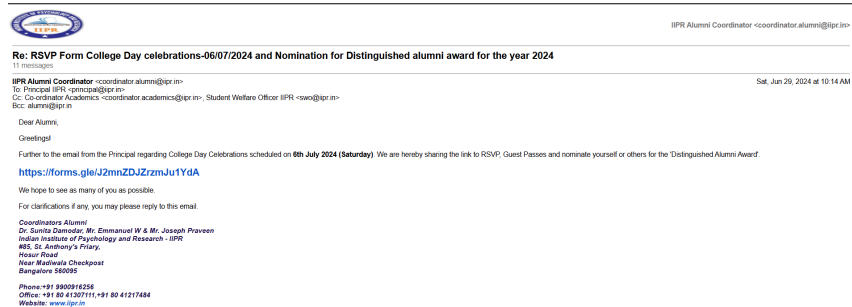
