Management of IIPR

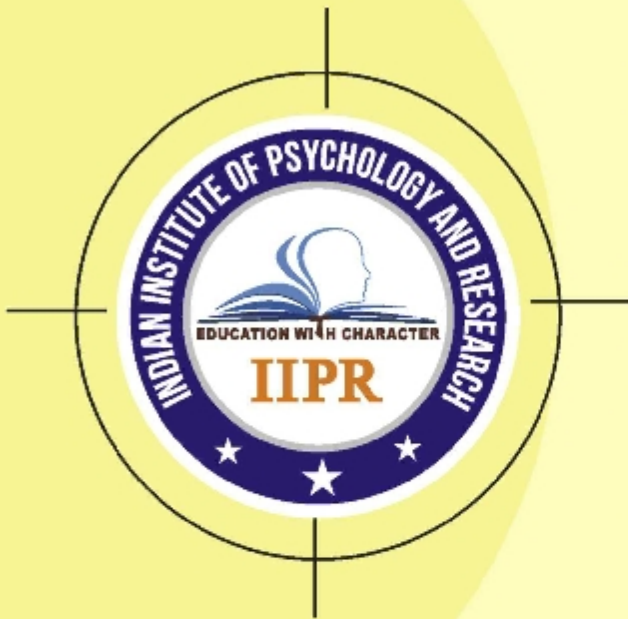

Curriculum and Teaching



IIPR follows the prescribed curriculum based on Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) of Bangalore Central University for undergraduate and postgraduate courses. 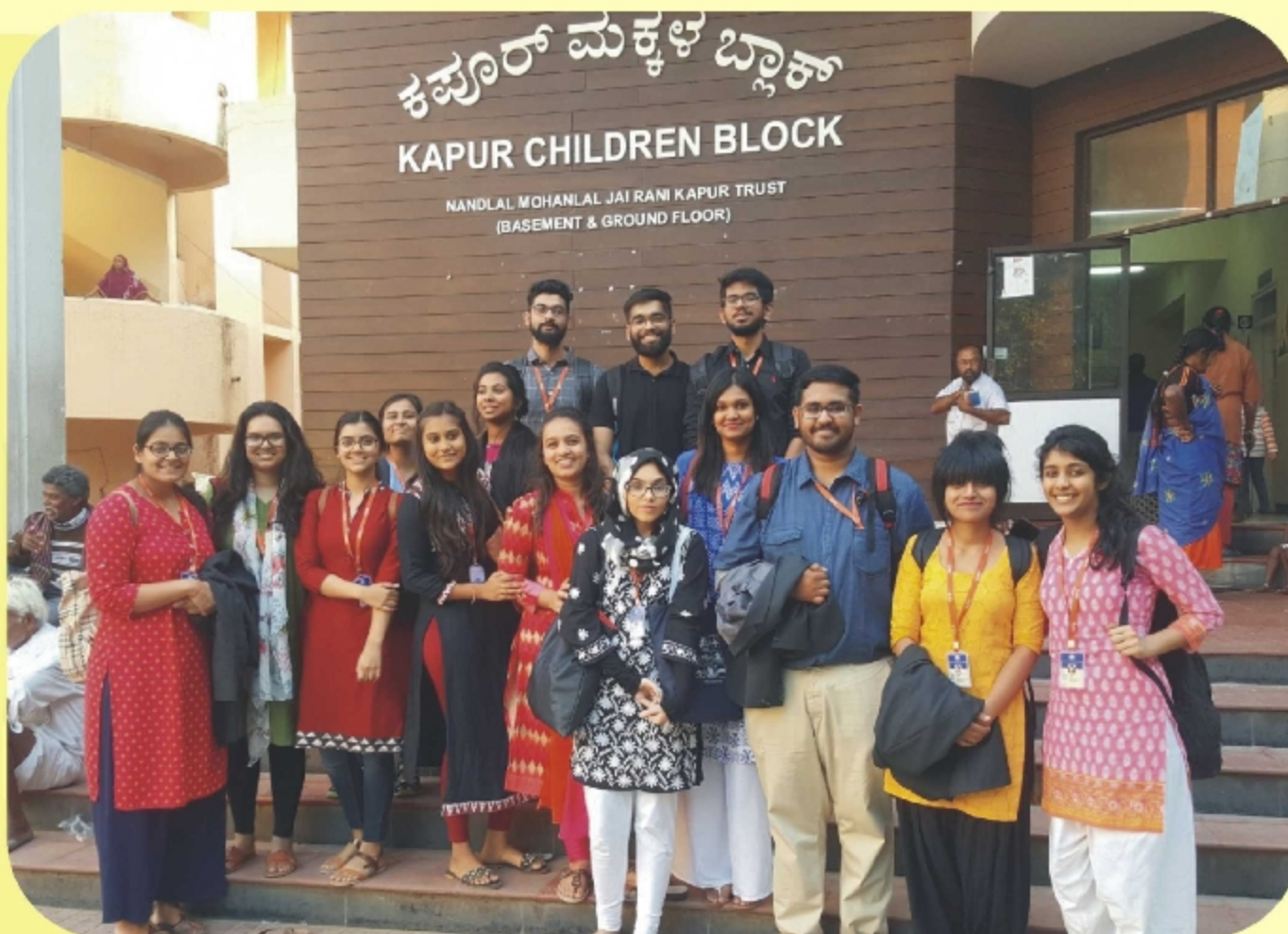
Extra-curricular (ECA) and Co-curricular (CC) activities:

Courses Offered:

Under Graduate (UG) Courses -

IIPR offers BA programmes following the three major system with unique combinations, enabling the student to pursue PG in any of the three majors.

1	B.A. in Psychology, Marketing, Economics (PME).	3 years (6 semesters of six months each).	Pass in P.U.C / 10+2/12th std with knowledge of English and minimum of 40% aggregate marks from any of the recognised boards like State Board/CBSE/ICSE /International Boards.
2	B.A. in Psychology, Journalism, Women Studies(PJW).		
3	B.A. in Psychology, Journalism, Optional English(PJO).		

Post Graduate (PG) Courses -

IIPR as an exclusive centre for Psychology offers two postgraduate programmes -

Sl.No	Course	Duration	Eligibility
1	M.Sc. in Psychology	2 years (4 Semesters of six months each).	40% aggregate at the Bachelor's Degree level with 50% marks in core subject Psychology from a UGC recognised university.
2	M.Sc. in Psychological Counselling	2 years (4 Semesters of six months each).	50% marks aggregate with Psychology as one of the subjects at the Bachelor's Degree or 1 year full time PG diploma with Psychology as a primary subject from a UGC recognised university.

Admission Process

IIPR admits eligible students for undergraduate and postgraduate courses through a structured and transparent admission process. Interested candidates may apply to the above mentioned courses by submitting duly filled application form.

I. Application Process:

1. Application forms can be collected from the Office of Admissions, IIPR on all working days between 9 am to 5 pm or could be downloaded from the college website www.iipr.in.
2. The required details in the application form should be completely filled up by the candidate in clear and block letters.
3. The details of the eligibility criteria and the application processing fee are available on our website – www.iipr.in/admission_procedure.html.
4. Submit the Application form along with the required enclosures – copies of mark statements and application processing fee (by cash/ DD/online payment through IIPR website).
5. Filled in applications can be sent through registered post, courier service or can be handed over at the Office of Admissions, IIPR.
6. On receipt of the filled application form the office of admissions will confirm the receipt through email along with the application number for further reference.



II. Selection Process:

1. On receipt of filled application forms along with the documents and processing fees, the office of admissions will contact the eligible candidates within 10 days with the information about the date of Interview.
2. Personal Interview - Short listed candidates will have to attend an interview for assessing their suitability to the course applied for.
 - The candidate has to present themselves physically at the office of admission for the personal interview. Original documents need to be produced for verification.
 - Online/Skype Interview - Candidates opting for online personal interview on Skype should have high speed Internet access with video conferencing facility. Further details in this regard will be sent by email to the candidate.

3. Entrance Examination (Only for PG courses)-Candidates applying for PG courses need to appear for entrance examination to assess their subject knowledge and aptitude for the course applied for.
4. Criteria for selection and preparation of merit list
 - Percentage of marks secured in the qualifying examination - 25% weightage for PG Courses, 50% weightage for UG courses.
 - Marks in Entrance test(only for PG courses) - 25%weightage.
 - Personal interview - 50% weightage

III. Admission Procedure:

1. Selected candidates will be intimated within 48 hours after the completion of the selection process by email/phone with details of the course selected for, the fee structure and with other required details.
2. Candidates selected need to pay the prescribed course fee within 4 working days to block their seat.
3. For details related to cancellation policy and course fee refund process kindly refer to the website - www.iipr.in/cancellation.html
4. Submission of all original documents is mandatory to complete the admission formalities and confirm the seat. Deadline for the same will be intimated to the candidate.
5. Once the admission formalities are completed cancellation request will not be accepted and course fee refund will not be available.
